I am a survivor of Rohwer where I was incarcerated for three years with my parents, grandparents, and siblings. During the past several years I have been interested to learn the history of the incarceration sites, and I have traveled to Rohwer, Manzanar and Tule Lake. I have visited the Topaz Museum on multiple trips, and I am so moved by the commitment and dedication of Jane Beckwith and the museum docents and the town of Delta to keep the stories of Topaz alive. I am especially impressed with the preservation of the Topaz historic site, where each of my visits has been a fascinating and poignant experience.

I am confident that the museum is in good hands. I am pleased that the Topaz Museum and site will continue to be a destination for future generations of my family to learn about the history of their ancestors.
